New Features

1. Support of the new Mac OSX 10.6 operation system. „Snow Leopard“ contains many changes in the OS for example how list of profiles need to be requested from the system, which made adjustments of ZePrA necessary.

Note: older versions of ZePrA won't run properly on Mac OSX 10.6.

Fixed Bugs

- Fixed the Demo license issue on older PowerPC Macs so that files will be converted.
- RGB and Gray TIFF files can now be processed again on older PowerPC Macs.
- Fixed that on some PC platforms Demo licenses did not work properly.
- TIFF and JPEG files and folder names using special characters (japanese characters) are now supported correctly.
- PDF file processing with Demo licenses has been optimized.
- Auto-Setup queues are now setting again *Like Device CMYK* for the conversion of *CMYK with embedded ICC profiles*. Older versions used *Covert to Document CMYK* as preset.
- Minor PDF bug fixes.
